



## LES COTEAUX ESTATE PINOT NOIR 2017

Les Coteaux means 'the hills' in French which represents both hillsides of our estate vineyards: the Résonance Vineyard and our Découverte Vineyard, both in the Willamette Valley. Organically dry-farmed, this dual estate vineyard blend shows the elegance and complexity coming from the soils and climate found at these neighboring sites. The result offers an original expression of the region's terroir.

### VINTAGE NOTES

Cold and wet winter and spring brought a late flowering (end of June). However the summer was one of the warmest (new record in August), giving very good condition of maturation. We started the harvest on September 28th with ripe and complex grapes of Pinot noir.

### TASTING NOTES

Coming from our single vineyards Résonance Vineyard (Yamhill-Carlton AVA) and Découverte Vineyard (Dundee Hills AVA), Les Coteaux has a beautiful ruby color. The nose reveals subtle notes of raspberry, cherry, clove, black pepper and rose petal. The palate is particularly elegant, well balanced between the fruity character of Découverte Vineyard and the noble structure of Résonance Vineyard: a beautiful harmony!
